


I feel I am able to effectively contribute to the council.




Top 3 challenges to 2020 participation.

I feel equipped to be an ambassador for Rebuild Upstate in my personal and professional communities.



MEETINGS


The quality, quantity, and timing of the information given to Advisory Council members in quarterly meetings is adequate.

There are a sufficient number of Advisory Council meetings per year. (Four quarterly)


Somewhat Agree
