Council Discussion

- DISCUSSION: WAKE UP & COVID?
 - Conclusion based on council input: a hybrid event would be best.
 - Lura Godfrey perspective as PTA president we may see a surge in cases in August. Michelle Gray similar perspective.
 - Don't add a virtual table ticket just keep the virtual ticket option on the registration so folks can register themselves.

• DISCUSSION: BRAND AWARENESS

- Doug Greenwell how do we grow excitement within specific neighborhoods/communities? Suggests Rebuild focus on specific areas. Abby would need Doug to speak with leadership + board because that would be a mission shift.
- Michelle + Sherry both express people aren't quite sure what RU is. Every time council has these conversations, you help grow awareness. Thank you!
- Challenge: Ethical balance of spreading the word about Rebuild Upstate with things that provide the most return on investment while ethically balancing a growing waiting list. That's why events like wake up are so successful because it has a huge return on investment.

• DISCUSSION: LOGISTICS PROBLEM?

Kylie - disagrees that we have a brand awareness problem. Feels we have a logistics problem (staff, volunteer engagement, tools) that is stopping us from fulfilling our mission effectively. How we can solve this? Abby will set up a meeting for interested council members and Rebuild Upstate staff leadership to listen to concerns, offer solutions, and identify ways the council can help with logistic challenges.
