- (S. 2651) is a bipartisan bill introduced in August 2025 to increase affordable housing supply and reduce regulatory barriers.

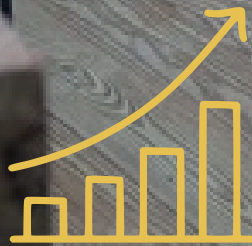

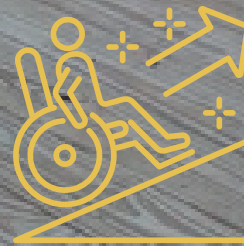
